REPORT ON THE POLICE AND CRIME COMMISSIONER FOR SOUTH WALES' ANNUAL REPORT 21- 22

Background

This report is made in accordance with the South Wales Police and Crime Panel's ("SWPCP") statutory duty contained in Paragraph 28(4) of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 ("the Act").

The Act states that a Police and Crime Panel must—

- (a) arrange for a public meeting of the panel to be held as soon as practicable after the panel is sent an annual report under section 12,
- (b) ask the police and crime commissioner, at that meeting, such questions about the annual report as the members of the panel think appropriate,
- (c) review the annual report, and
- (d) make a report or recommendations on the annual report to the commissioner.
